BASED ON INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE, TIYAN GUAM AND COMPILED AT CNMI HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, GOVERNOR ELOY S. INOS, WOULD LIKE TO INFORM THE GENERAL PUBLIC THAT, A TROPICAL STORM WATCH REMAINS IN EFFECT FOR SAIPAN AND TINIAN. A TYPHOON WATCH IS NOW IN EFFECT FOR ALAMAGAN AND PAGAN.

## ... TROPICAL DEPRESSION 06W UPGRADED TO TROPICAL STORM TAPAH...

AT 100 PM CHST THIS AFTERNOON THE CENTER OF TROPICAL STORM TAPAH 06W WAS LOCATED BY SATELLITE AND RADAR NEAR LATITUDE 12.9 DEGREES NORTH AND LONGITUDE **147.3 DEGREES EAST**. THIS IS ABOUT:

**160 MILES EAST-SOUTHEAST OF ROTA 180 MILES SOUTHEAST OF TINIAN 180 MILES SOUTH SOUTHEAST OF SAIPAN** 

TROPICAL STORM TAPAH 06W IS MOVING NORTHEAST AT 7 MPH. MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS HAVE INCREASED TO 60 MPH. TAPAH IS EXPECTED TO TURN IN A MORE NORTHERLY DIRECTION LATER TODAY GRADUALLY TURNING TO THE NORTH-NORTHWEST OVERNIGHT AND TUESDAY WITH LITTLE CHANGE IN FORWARD SPEED.

**TROPICAL STORM TAPAH 06W** IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE TO INTENSIFY AND REACH TYPHOON INTENSITY WITHIN NEXT 6 TO 12 HOURS. TROPICAL STORM FORCE WINDS EXTEND OUTWARD UP TO 35 MILES FROM THE CENTER.

THE CNMI HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT WILL BE MONITORING THE MOVEMENT OF TROPICAL STORM TAPAH 06W AND WILL BE ISSUING BULLETINS AS THEY BECOME AVAILABLE. PLEASE CONTINUE TO MONITOR THE OFFICIAL BULLETINS WHICH WILL BE AVAILABLE THROUGH LOCAL MEDIA SOURCES AND NOAA WEATHER RADIO BROADCAST ON 162.5 MEGAHERTZ, OR CALL CNMI EOC DISPATCH CENTER AT 237-8000 OR 211, AND FOR THE NORTHERN ISLANDS TO CONTACT CNMI EOC DISPATCH CENTER AT HIGH FREQUENCY SINGLE SIDE BAND RADIO ON FREQUENCY 5.205.0.
