TROPICAL STORM TAPAH 06W BULLETIN NO. 006

HERE IS THE LATEST INFORMATION ON TROPICAL STORM TAPAH 06W AS RECEIVED FROM NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE TIYAN GUAM AND COMPILED AT THE CNMI HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR.

AT 1000 AM CHST THIS MORNING, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL STORM TAPAH 06W WAS LOCATED BY SATELLITE AND RADAR NEAR LATITUDE 15.7 DEGREES NORTH AND LONGITUDE 147.4 DEGREES EAST OR ABOUT,

185 MILES NORTHEAST OF ROTA

130 MILES EAST-NORTHEAST OF TINIAN

120 MILES EAST-NORTHEAST OF SAIPAN

170 MILES SOUTHEAST OF ALAMAGAN AND

195 MILES SOUTH-SOUTHEAST OF PAGAN

TROPICAL STORM TAPAH IS MOVING NORTH AT 13 MPH. TAPAH IS EXPECTED TO TURN TO THE NORTHWEST LATER TODAY WITH LITTLE CHANGE IN FORWARD SPEED.

MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS REMAINS AT 65 MPH. TROPICAL STORM TAPAH IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE SLOWLY INTENSIFYING THROUGH THIS AFTERNOON POSSIBLY REACHING TYPHOON INTENSITY TROUGH LATE THIS MORNING BEFORE BEGINNING A GRADUAL WEAKENING TREND WEDNESDAY. TROPICAL STORM FORCE WINDS EXTEND OUTWARD UP TO 80 MILES FROM THE CENTER.

BECAUSE OF THE ANTICIPATED THREAT OF TROPICAL STORM TAPAH 06W, GOVERNOR ELOY S. INOS HAS MAINTAINED TROPICAL STORM CONDITION II AND TYPHOON WATCH FOR THE ISLANDS OF ALAMAGAN AND PAGAN AS OF 11:30A.M THIS MORNING. WE ARE DOWNGRADING ALERT LEVEL TO AN "ALL CLEAR" FOR SAIPAN AND TINIAN.

THE FOLLOWING SCHOOLS WILL REMAIN CLOSED TODAY BUT WILL RESUME TOMORROW:

- PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOR SAIPAN AND TINIAN
- MT. CARMEL SCHOOL
