BASED ON INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE, TIYAN GUAM AND COMPILED AT CNMI HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, **GOVERNOR ELOY S. INOS**, WOULD LIKE TO INFORM THE GENERAL PUBLIC THAT, A **TROPICAL STORM WATCH IS NOW IN EFFECT FOR SAIPAN, TINIAN, ALAMAGAN AND PAGAN**. A TROPICAL STORM WATCH MEANS TROPICAL STORM FORCE WINDS OF 39 MPH OR GREATER ARE POSSIBLE WITHIN 48 HOURS.

...TROPICAL STORM WATCH IS NOW IN EFFECT...

AT **700 AM** CHST THIS MORNING THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION 06W WAS LOCATED BY SATELLITE NEAR LATITUDE **12.5 DEGREES NORTH** AND LONGITUDE **146.5 DEGREES EAST**. THIS IS ABOUT:

135 MILES EAST SOUTH-THEAST OF GUAM
165 MILES SOUTH-SOUTHEAST OF ROTA
215 MILES SOUTH-SOUTHEAST OF TINIAN
220 MILES SOUTH OF SAIPAN

TROPICAL DEPRESSION 06W IS MOVING NORTH AT 6 MPH. MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS HAVE INCREASED TO 35 MPH. **TROPICAL DEPRESSION 06W** IS EXPECTED TO SLOWLY INTENSIFY DURING THE NEXT 24 HOURS.

TROPICAL DEPRESSION 06W IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE ITS SLOW MOVEMENT TO THE NORTH TODAY, GRADUALLY TURNING TO THE NORTHWEST OVERNIGHT AND TUESDAY WITH LITTLE CHANGE IN FORWARD SPEED.

THE CNMI HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT WILL BE MONITORING THE MOVEMENT OF **TROPICAL DEPRESSION 06W** AND WILL BE ISSUING BULLETINS AS THEY BECOME AVAILABLE. PLEASE CONTINUE TO MONITOR THE OFFICIAL BULLETINS WHICH WILL BE AVAILABLE THROUGH LOCAL MEDIA SOURCES AND NOAA WEATHER RADIO BROADCAST ON **162.5** MEGAHERTZ, OR CALL CNMI EOC DISPATCH CENTER AT **237-8000** OR **211**, AND FOR THE NORTHERN ISLANDS TO CONTACT CNMI EOC DISPATCH CENTER AT HIGH FREQUENCY SINGLE SIDE BAND RADIO ON FREQUENCY **5.205.0**.
