



## Nursing Assistant Program

### Admission Guidelines & Cost Breakdown

#### Admissions and Registration

1. Interested applicants must apply to the Northern Marianas College through our [NMC Admissions Application](#). The application requires individuals to submit an official high school or high school equivalency transcript and a copy of a valid, government-issued photo ID.
2. Individuals must place in English level EN095 (Integrated Reading & Writing II) or higher, and in Math level MA091 (Beginning Algebra) or higher. Applicants can schedule to take the English and Math Placement Tests with the NMC Testing Center via [Google Forms here](#). For more information, visit [www.marianas.edu/testingervices](http://www.marianas.edu/testingervices).
3. Applicants must submit an [NMC Health Evaluation Form](#), which can be filled out and completed at any private clinic. The health evaluation form must validate vaccinations for *measles, mumps, rubella, tetanus, hepatitis B, and COVID-19*; and you must also provide results of the current PPD skin test (current = two years).
  - a. **For ongoing NMC students**, they must submit a copy of their NMC Health Evaluation Form which can be obtained by request to the Office of Admissions and Records. Students can submit the form to Andrew Mendiola, Nursing Department Administrative Assistant, at [andrew.mendiola@marianas.edu](mailto:andrew.mendiola@marianas.edu).
4. Once all documents and requirements have been reviewed and met, applicants will receive an NMC acceptance letter and gain access to their student email, NMC Moodle, and Proa Portal accounts.
5. Students will then need to contact the course instructor, Rosa T. Aldan, at [rosa.tudela@marianas.edu](mailto:rosa.tudela@marianas.edu) for approval to register for the NU095 Nursing Assistant course. Students will register for classes through their NMC Proa Portal account.
6. Registration for the NU095 Nursing Assistant course will begin on March 31, 2023 until seats are filled. Due to limited seating capacity, this is a first-come-first-serve basis.
