The Board of Regents is the unit of authority, and no Board member has individual authority in regards to the College except as part of that unit. Individually the Board member may not commit the college or Regents to any policy, act or expenditure. The Board member cannot do business with the College, nor should the Board member have an interest in any contract with the College. The Board member does not represent any factional segment of the community, but is rather a part of the body, which represents and acts for the community as a whole.

No individual member of the Board, by virtue of holding office, shall exercise any administrative responsibility with respect to the College or as an individual command the services of any college employee.

No member of the Board shall be asked to perform any routine or clerical duties that may be assigned to an employee, nor shall any Board member become an employee of the College while serving on the Board.
