APPLICATION DEADLINE: AUG. 20 2010 NMC Natural Resources Management Scholarship Program Purpose of The purpose of the Northern Marianas College Natural Resources Management (NRM) Scholarship Program is threefold: 1) To promote higher education by providing financial assistance for college students in their pursuit of professional careers in Scholarship natural resources management; 2) to help alleviate the critical current and future shortage of skilled and trained natural resource management workforce for the CNMI; and, 3) to provide current public and private sector employees with opportunities to improve their knowledge and skills, and enhance their career and professional development. Guidelines The NRM Scholarship Program will award 10 scholarships to full time students (enrolled for at least 12 credits) and 15 scholarships to part time students (enrolled for at least 6 credits) pursuing their Associate of Science degree in Natural Resources Management. The scholarships will be awarded based on financial need, merit, eligibility, content of each student's written essay, and interview process. To be eligible for this scholarship, a student must: Conditions of 1. Be a U.S. citizen (or green card holder) and a CNMI resident for the past three years; Scholarship 2. Be accepted **and enrolled** as a full-time or part time student at NMC: Eligibility Have a high school or college cumulative GPA of 2.00 or better; 4. Be seeking an NMC degree as specified in the guidelines above in the academic semester in which the scholarship is being awarded; 5. If selected to receive scholarship, applicant must sign an agreement stating that he or she will work in the Commonwealth after graduating from the Northern Marianas College for a period twice as long as the period for which applicant received the NMC Natural Resources Management Scholarship. 6. Demonstrate financial need. Application Applicants may obtain an application form from the NMC Financial Aid Office or the NMC Instructional Sites in Tinian and Rota. All applications and required documents must be received by the NMC Financial Aid Office on or before the deadline. Procedures The application packet should include the following: An official NMC Natural Resources Management Scholarship application form: All necessary official high school or college academic transcripts; Proof of citizenship (copy of current US Passport or court/hospital issued Birth Certificate); A **Letter of Acceptance** from NMC stating the intended major: At least one (1) Letter of Recommendation from an individuals who has knowledge of applicant's academic background and potential; One written essay that should clearly address two issues: 1) why applicant is most deserving of the academic scholarship; and 2) what applicant plans to do or pursue after graduating from NMC (See written essay requirements). Selection Criteria Applicants will be selected based on: Financial Need 1. 2. Community service or extra-curricular involvement – list service involvement and # of hours; 3. One (1) letter of recommendation; 4. A two-page written essay by the applicant (see written essay requirements below); An interview **may** be required. Written Essay The written essay should clearly address two issues: 1) why applicant is most deserving of the academic scholarship; and, 2) what applicant plans to do or pursue after graduating from NMC. The format of the written essay should be Typed; Double Requirements Spaced; Font Type: Times New Roman; Font Size: 12 Point; 2 Page Maximum. **Duration** of It is the intent of the NMC Natural Resources Management Scholarship program to provide financial support to qualified recipients in in the Fall 2010 and Spring 2010 semesters. Scholarship recipients may reapply for continued aid in subsequent Award semesters. Benefits and remaining scholarship balances may be transferred to subsequent semesters for the payment of educational services (including tuition, fees, and books). Award Amounts Each recipient will receive up to \$1,140 (for full time students) or \$570 (for part time students) per semester. The award will remain in the name of the recipient and will be placed in the custody of the Northern Marianas College's Finance Office for the respective period. The award will be used strictly for payment of educational services (including tuition, fees, books, etc.) received from NMC. The award may not be withdrawn for cash and is non-transferable. Scholarships will be awarded to the eligible recipients by the start of the qualifying semester. Suspension of 1. If the recipient fails to maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.00, or if the number of credits hours drops below that of a full-time or part time status at the end of each semester, the scholarship recipient must re-apply to be considered for the scholarship Award during subsequent semesters. 2. If the recipient completely withdraws from the semester in which the scholarship is received for, the recipient forfeits their scholarship award.
