## Statement on Progress Report Preparation

On June 29, 2007 the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC) informed the Northern Marianas College (NMC) that it had reviewed and accepted the March 30, 2007 Progress Report and decided to continue the College on Probation. The College has acted to continue to address Eligibility Requirement #5, Commission Recommendations 1 and 2, and the team recommendations.

The issues in the October 15, 2007 Progress Report were discussed in detail with the college community using its existing committees and councils. Fernandez developed the Ad Hoc Progress Report Committee (Chief Financial and President Carmen Administrative Officer, Dean of Academic Programs and Services, Dean of Student Services, Dean of Community Programs and Services, Director of Information Technology, Director of Institutional Advancement, and the Accreditation Liaison Officer) to take the lead in writing and reviewing the report through collaborative work with other members of the college community. Direct involvement in the input and writing of the Progress Report was expanded by the creation of the Tinian and Rota Instructional Work Group, which focused primarily Recommendation 1. The Work Group included members of the Ad Hoc Progress Report Committee, the Tinian and Rota Program Coordinators, Faculty Senate President, ASNMC President, and the Staff Senate President. Committee and the Work Group communicated directly with College Council, Academic Council, School of Education, Counseling Programs and Services, Library Programs and Services, Office of Institutional Effectiveness, Human Resources, and others in writing and reviewing the report.

The final draft prior to final editing was presented for review to the Board of Regents Program Committee on October 8, 2007. The Board reviewed the report with the Management Team, Ad Hoc Progress Report Committee and the Work Group.

The October 15, 2007 Progress Report is submitted for the purpose of addressing the concerns raised by the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges and the Accrediting Commission for Senior Colleges and Universities.

I certify that there was broad participation by the college community and we believe this Progress Report accurately reflects the actions taken by the institution.
